When you give a lunch or a dinner, do not ask your friends, brothers, relations or rich neighbours, for fear they repay your courtesy by inviting you in return.

There seems to be a certain reciprocity about children's birthday parties: an expectation that if you are invited to someone's you should invite them in return. An inability or failure to do so can often be the cause of stress or tension. Of course, once we are mature enough we understand that this isn't a particularly grown up approach. We invite others because it pleases us to do so.

Lesson three in economics from a God's-eye view teaches us about the nature of Christian giving – it is just that, pure gift, made out of love. The reward is in the giving itself and in the way that such a life of virtue prepares us to enjoy the gift of heaven. This should not surprise us, for in the art of giving freely and without expectation of reward we imitate our creator and our saviour. The Father loves us into being simply because it pleases him. The Son gives himself for us out of love of his Father and out of love for us, not for his own reward or glory. Indeed, he leaves his glory behind for our sake.

The welcoming of strangers at the table marked the ministry of Jesus and it marks Christian hospitality too. It is one of the powerful signs of the work that God has done in us, and is a really good way of inviting others to share more deeply in the truth of God's love for them. As we move towards some new things in our parish, I wonder if you would be up for some hospitality, whether making an invitation to someone for tea and toast, a bowl of soup and a bit of cheese, or fellowship over a meal?
