How to distinguish between Rapture us. Return

As prophesied, the Lord Jesus is coming again. First in the sky for Rapture, and again seven years later to defeat Satan and rule as King of the Earth from Jerusalem. The simplest way to distinguish between scriptures about the Rapture and the Second Coming of Christ, is to determine if the verse in question is referring to the Lord coming "for" His saints (I Thes 4:16), or "with" His saints (I Thes 3:13). Here is a list (not exhaustive) of the differences in the two events:

FIVE DIFFERENT VIEWS ON THE RAPTURE

Basic definitions of the most common beliefs about when the Rapture will happen.

PRE-TRIBULATION

The Rapture will take place before the time of wrath (called the Tribulation) comes. The Church is removed from the whole period of Tribulation—the entire seven years.

MID-TRIBULATION

The Rapture of Christians will take place at the midpoint of the seven-year Tribulation period (3 1/2 years).

PARTIAL RAPTURE

Suggests multiple raptures that will occur throughout the Tribulation period based on the level of faithfulness of each person.


PRE-WRATH

The Rapture will happen 5 1/2 years into the Tribulation period. This view places the Rapture of Christians between the sixth and seventh seals described in the book of Revelation.

POST-TRIBULATION

The Church will go through the entire Tribulation, but be preserved from the wrath of God, the divine wrath, only to be taken up very quickly prior to the Second Coming of Christ to the earth and to meet Him in the air and come back to the earth with Him.







But the key point for Paul here is the order of events when Jesus comes. The Thessalonians had come to believe that dying before the return of Jesus would involve some sort of

disadvantage in eternity, probably eternal physical separation from those who lived until Jesus' return.

In this text Paul assures the Thessalonians that the living believers do not "precede," or have any advantage over, the dead. The dead in Christ are the ones who rise first (see Rev. 20:4-6). That happons before the living ascend to meet Jesus in the air (1 Thess. 4:17). The righteous dead are resurrected and given immortality along with those who are alive when He returns.
