*	It is important to know God's will. God's will is As we seek God's will, we should make sure what we are considering is not something the Bible  Also, we should make sure what we are considering will God and help us and others grow
*	Knowing God's will is sometimes difficult because it requires It's natural to want to know all of God's will at once, but that's not how He usually works.
*	Often, we want God to give us God allows us to make choices, and, is we are yielded to Him, He has ways of preventing wrong choices (Acts 16:6–7).
*	If we are walking closely with the Lord and truly desiring His will for our lives, God will place His in our hearts. The key is wanting God's will, not our own (Ps. 37:4).
*	To know God's will, we must hear God's (John 10:27). These are the sheep who hear and recognize His voice, because they know Him as their Shepherd.
*	We hear His voice when we spend time in Bible and of His Word. The more time we spend intimately with God and His Word, the easier it is to recognize His voice and His leading in our lives.
*	While God could speak audibly to people today, He speaks primarily through His written
