I would like to invite you to take up a little challenge with me. Can you figure out the equation above? The answer is 0.0119047619047619. But why do I point it out to you? What is the meaning behind this challenge, beyond figuring out a mathematical calculation? I'll give you a second to ponder that before I answer that question. If you're reading this article, I would encourage you to think about why I would pose such a challenge before moving on to the next paragraph for an answer.

(A moment for some quiet reflection!)

Okay, if you are ready, here is what this challenge is all about. I am challenging each member of the congregation to give two hours to the Lord this upcoming fall. Truthfully, I would hope that you give Him all 168 hours out of the week, which is the number of hours there are each week. They are after all His, He just entrust them into your care. But for this challenge I am asking you to consider prayerfully engaging in worship for one hour, and to participate in a Bible study for one more hour. That's two hours of the 168 hours you have been given weekly. That just a little over 1.1% of your week. And if you are thinking that you sleep on average 56 hours (8 hours a night), so the number ought to be 124 hours, that is still only 1.7% of your time.

How do you fulfill this challenge? Come to worship each week. That takes care of one hour. Then participate in Sunday School or Adult Bible Class on Sunday morning. If you don't attend that, attend one of the other Bible studies that take place during the week. Check out the calendar for a list of some of those options. I know that there are online options, and yes, they would count towards fulfilling this challenge, but I would highly encourage being physically present in the Lord's house (or with others in your Bible study setting), as there is just no substitute for being with brothers and sisters in Christ.

I truly believe the Lord will bless you if you take up this challenge. I am not enforcing this upon you or demanding it.... It is a completely open opportunity to allow the Lord to bless you with His Word and Sacrament for at least two hours each week. I know some of you are already fulfilling this challenge, and I hope most are doing personal devotions and other things to grow your faith which would raise the percentage of this challenge... great! But,

even if you are already meeting the ¹⁶⁸ *Challenge*, seek to engage more deeply

into those two hours of worship and Bible study. And here is some good news, if you don't live up to the challenge one week, you get a new opportunity the next week to take up the challenge again. There is no time limit, and it's always open. Join me in this special challenge this fall!



ELDERS REPORT

Gary reported that the Shepherd List & Shut-in Lists have been distributed. The are working on the sound system situation and actively looking for an organist.

PLANNING COMMITTEE REPORT

Shirley was not in attendance. Pastor did mention that we will be trying to do a new member welcome soon, as a couple of individuals are looking in to taking the classes.

TRUSTEE REPORT

Jared didn't have anything to report.

PASTOR'S REPORT

Pastor Rob reported that we are looking in to the organist, piano situation. He stated that the going rate is any where from \$55-\$60 per service. We have \$5000 budgeted for this. He has contacted Sam Jilka regarding the church landscaping and he said that he can not take on anymore at this time. He visited with John Jordening and he suggested we contact Natural Escapes in Cozad. In the meantime, John will remove the trees out front. The robot mower that we have been using may require a 3 prong outlet. Fagot Electric will come and take care of that. Regarding weekly attendance, he has looked back over the course of 2022 and compared to last year, it has been very similar. He has not seen much of a decline by going to one service. Pastor Rob stated that he will be gone Friday, July 29- Sunday, July 31st. to Memphis. Pastor Whitt will be filling in on Saturday and Pastor Bill will be back for Sunday's service. Josie suggested that we have a few more contemporary songs in the Sunday Services. Some discussion was held on that as well as the current way of distributing communion.

OLD BUSINESS

Discussed plans with the sound system. Jared asked if the sound system for the fellowship hall will include the kitchen. We may need to add an additional speaker in the kitchen if needed. Need Board of Education Report included for May's Voter's Meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

Installation of officers is usually done the last Sunday of July, but Pastor Rob will be gone. Option to install the officers on 8/7/22 and have the board meeting on the 8^{th} or install the 24^{th} and have the meeting on 8/2/22. It was decided to meet on Tuesday the 2^{nd} @ 6:00. We are in need of a secretary. Pastor suggested that we ask Carol Ziebel if she would want to serve another year.
