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### Prayer intentions for the season of creation

Here are some suggestions for prayers during the season of creation, which runs to 4th October, the feast of Saint Francis of Assisi.

... that we may renew our relationships with God our Creator, and with all creation.

... for our own ecological conversion, and that of all peoples, that we may

open our hearts to hear and respond to the cries of anguish in our world,  
*'so that we and future generations can continue to rejoice in creation's  
sweet song of life and hope.'*

... with thanks for all that God has made, repent for the damage that we  
have caused and commit ourselves to take action to protect the earth, our  
common home.

... for the success of COP27, the next United Nations Climate Change  
Conference, due to take place in November in Egypt, and for COP15, the  
UN Convention on Biological Diversity, due to take place in the autumn in  
China; that they can serve to unite the human family in effectively  
confronting the double crisis of climate change and the reduction of  
biodiversity.

... that we may be able to listen. *'If we learn how to listen, we can hear in  
the voice of creation a kind of dissonance. On the one hand, we can hear  
a sweet song in praise of our beloved Creator; on the other, an anguished  
plea, lamenting our mistreatment of this our common home.'*
