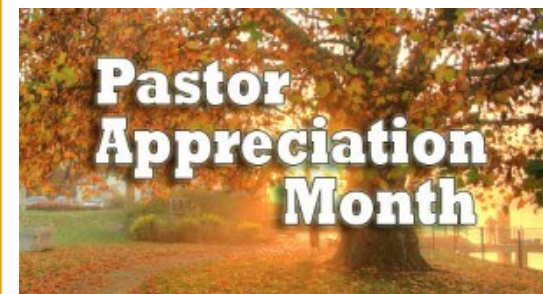


Pastor Appreciation Day Church Dinner

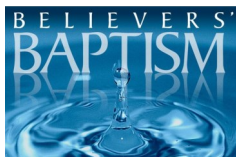

Send good news and great joy in Jesus’ name to the ends of the earth! Donations can be dropped off at any time in the box by the Resource Table. Thanks!

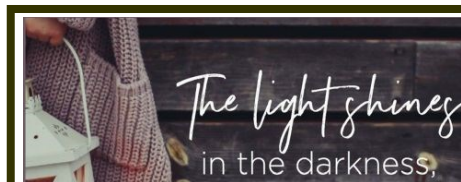
NOTE: We will once again serve as a local collection site for our community the week of November 14-21 (12-2PM). If you can help, please let us know!

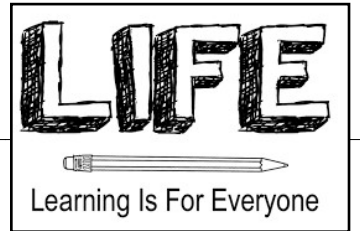
