Sermon Notes

MORE THAN SURVIVORS: WHAT IT TAKES TO THRIVE SPIRITUALLY "We Are More Than Survivors!"

By faith Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance, obeyed and went, even though he did not know where he was going. By faith he made his home in the promised land like a stranger in a foreign country ... For he was looking forward to the city with foundations, whose architect and builder is God (Hebrews 11:8 NIV).

Observations (Romans 8:28-39): 1. God is And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose (Romans 8:28 NIV).		
	Two qualifiers:	
	A. Those who Him.	
	B. Who have been	according to His purpose.



Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or hardship or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword?... No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord (Romans 8:35-39 NIV).

For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son (Romans 8:29a NIV).

Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ (1 Corinthians 11:1 NIV).

We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not abandoned, struck down, but not destroyed (2 Corinthians 4:8–9 NIV).
