HYMN OF THE DAY: The theme for this Sunday is *God invites us to mercy*. Our hymn of the day, *Amazing Grace (My Chains Are Gone)*, helps us to picture the mercy of God. It is a mercy that finds the lost, frees the chained, ransoms the condemned. It is a mercy that extends to all people because Christ gave himself as a sacrifice for every person. It is a mercy that God invites us to receive, and a mercy that God invites us to share with others as his children.

A WORD: Our theme for this Sunday is *God invite us to mercy*. In Jonah 4, we find the prophet angry because God showed his mercy to the Ninevites when they repented. But through the story of the plant, God invites Jonah to enter his mercy. If Jonah feels pity for the plant (which is a little thing), how much more should God show pity for the Ninevites, a people whom he created and whom he loves? Likewise, our epistle lesson shows us how we are to share in God's mercy, by praying for all people, in the knowledge that Christ died as a ransom for every person.

Finally, Jesus reminds us in the Gospel lesson that God shows mercy both to the just and the unjust. Therefore, as children of the heavenly Father, our mercy is to be perfect, not withheld from those we hate, but offered to our friends and our enemies alike.

BIBLE READINGS FOR NEXT SUNDAY: Genesis 50:15-21 Romans 8:26-30 Luke 6:17-36

Paul shows us the fulfillment of the psalmist's words when he says, God "raised us up with [Christ] and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus" (Ephesians 2:6).
