LESSONS FROM FIRST SAMUEL

1 Samuel 18:6-12 "When the men were returning home after David had killed the Philistine, the women came out from all the towns of Israel to meet King Saul with singing and dancing, with joyful songs and with timbrels and lyres. ⁷ As they danced, they sang: "Saul has slain his thousands, and David his tens of thousands." ⁸ Saul was very angry; this refrain displeased him greatly. "They have credited David with tens of thousands," he thought, "but me with only thousands. What more can he get but the kingdom?" ⁹ And from that time on Saul kept a close eye on David. ¹⁰ The next day an evil spirit from God came forcefully on Saul. He was prophesying in his house, while David was playing the lyre, as he usually did. Saul had a spear in his hand ¹¹ and he hurled it, saying to himself, "I'll pin David to the wall." But David eluded him twice. ¹² Saul was afraid of David, because the Lord was with David but had departed from Saul."

LESSONS FOR US:

- Love Your Enemies.
 - When those who don't follow God, see that God is blessing those who do follow Him, it can bring out various emotions in them; anger, displeasure, jealousy, murder and fear, like in the case of King Saul.
 - Let us think ahead, about how we will react, when approached by those who don't follow God. Three times we are commanded NOT to pay back evil for evil; Romans 12:17, 1 Thessalonians 5:15 and 1 Peter 3:9. Jesus said we are to love our enemies; Matthew 5:44
