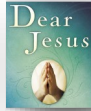
Our church is prepared for services each week by HBC volunteers who do the vacuuming and necessary cleaning. Please sign up today on the sign up sheet in the foyer.

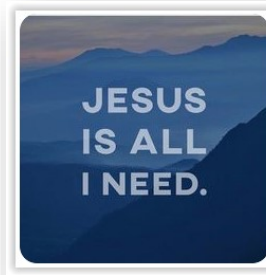

Jesus Christ came into the world, born to Mary in Bethlehem just as God had promised hundreds of years before. He was human in every way. Yet at the same time, He was also fully God.
