MORE THAN SURVIVORS: WHAT IT TAKES TO THRIVE SPIRITUALLY

“Red Alert! Shields Up!”

Genesis 39:1–23

While the story of Joseph focuses on the evil of sexual sin, that isn’t the only sin that is all-too convenient.

Every one of us can be _____ to temptation.

If you think you are standing strong, be careful not to fall. The temptations in your life are no different from what others experience. And God is faithful. He will not allow the temptation to be more than you can stand. When you are tempted, he will show you a way out so that you can endure (1 Cor. 10:12-13 NLT).

Now Joseph was well-built and handsome,⁷ and after a while his master’s wife took notice of Joseph (Genesis 39:6-7 NIV).
