**HYMN OF THE DAY:** The Word of God is powerful, but only when God is active through it. Apart from God's power, Scripture is nothing more than words on a page, no different from any other book. But when God chooses to act through it, it accomplishes every purpose for which God sends it. Therefore, whenever we read the Word, hear the Word, or encounter the Word, we pray that God would be active in it. So we close our service this morning by doing just that. Almighty Father, bless your Word.

**A WORD:** Today's theme is the Word of God. From the conversion of Lydia, we learn how Christ chooses to be active in our world today, through his Word. Paul preached the Gospel to Lydia, and as he spoke the Lord "opened her heart to pay attention to what was said by Paul." Christ became active in Lydia's heart as the Word was preached. That Word was then applied to her personally in baptism. Paul also talks about the Word in our epistle lesson. The Word of Christ is near to us and brings salvation to us as it is received by faith into our hearts.

Finally, the Gospel lesson shows us that the Word of God is not a what; it is a who, Jesus Christ. He is the Word of God made flesh, from whom we receive God's grace and through whom we come to know God face to face.
