Everyone is encouraged to attend this service at Westminster Presbyterian Church in Bandon. The Rev. Wright Busching, a church

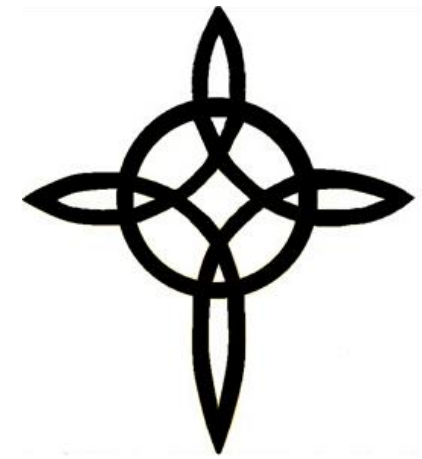
planter from University Presbyterian Mission, will be the preacher. The offering will go to support the University Presbyterian Mission that will be planted in the USF area.
