Our church is prepared for services each week by HBC volunteers who do the vacuuming and necessary cleaning. Please sign up today on the sign up sheet in the foyer.

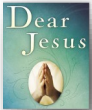

Lot knew God through his uncle Abraham, yet when he moved to Sodom he did not reach others with the truth. There were not even ten righteous people to be found, not because the city was wicked, but because the Christians were weak.
