Dear Friends,

This month marks the 125th anniversary of a symbol we see every week but rarely think about – the Christian Flag.

The idea for such a flag came about due to a peculiar reason – the main speaker for a New York Sunday School rally (held on September 26, 1897) didn't show up. In his place, the Sunday School superintendent, Charles C. Overton, was forced to give an impromptu speech. Seeing a United States flag nearby, he began to talk about the symbolism of flags and suggested that the Christian church needed a flag of its own.



Despite the fact that Overton had only thought of this idea off the top of his head, the concept stayed with him, and upon going home he designed a flag. It didn't take long before the flag spread across the world as a prominent symbol of Protestant churches. The fact that Overton refused to trademark or copyright the flag also means that it has been free to be copied and recreated by anyone throughout the years.

On the Christian flag, "white represents purity and peace, blue indicates fidelity, and red stands for the shed blood of Christ." The blue can also represent the waters of baptism. In the 1930s official rules were set in place for etiquette concerning the Christian flag: "The Christian flag code states that it should be placed either at floor level, outside the railing to the right of the congregation, or on the right side of the altar, pulpit, or choir as it faces the congregation. When displayed with the American flag, it should be on the same level, to the right of the American flag, and dips only to the cross at the altar."

At least three pledges to the Christian flag are in use. The one used in our Sunday school openings is the oldest and was written by a Methodist pastor named Lynn Harold Hough.

In this day and age, when almost all traditional symbols are targets, the Christian flag has been a subject of controversy among church leadership and secular activists. However, for churches like our own, it is simply a reminder that the basic faith we follow is shared by countless others on every continent, raising the same standard, following the same savior.
