- Pray for Justine Schumaker for healing from cancer.

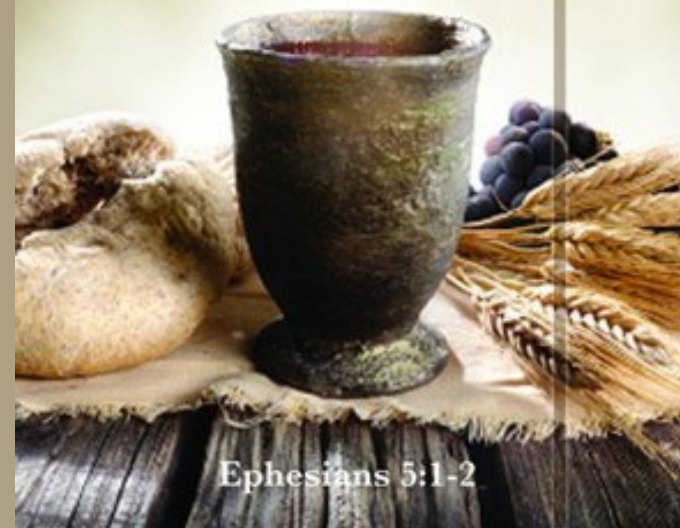
