Bible study groups or meetings together usually take place under a tree or in someone's house. As these groups grow a building is needed to meet in. Sitting on the ground or being stuffed in someone's house is getting old. The church is being built, it is the people who come and study the word of God.

At this time we need a building to take the place of the ground, shade from under a tree, or standing in someone's house.

Building materials don't just show up. One has to find a couple of trees! They are usually not close to where the building needs to be built.







This is all freshly cut lumber and it needs to be notched and nailed together before it dries.







The fellows are working hard these days to get ahead of the upcoming rainy season. This building will be built three feet off the ground.



The river dosen't always over

flow this much. We are planning ahead so our new building won't be flooded with mud or animals that would make a mess of the building.

Would you like to help us finish this project? We are in need of prayer for this building to a be a HUGE blessing to those who use it. We also could use financial help to finish it. We had some funds to begin but

not enough to finish it. We lack approximately \$5,000 for roofing, some bricks for a partition wall, and screen to enclose the rest of the building to keep out the three B's - bugs, bats and birds.

This building will also serve as a central location for small conferences. Usually the leaders from this location travel to other locations for Bible studies. When this building is complete it will also be a place to show the many videos that have been recorded in their languages over the years. No more sitting outside in the evening watching a video while bugs attack the screen.



"A Ray of Light and Hope" has begun for

getting the miracle radio station at Horeb back on the air. You read right! We just received some information about a debt that needs to be paid before further paper work can go forward on relicensing the station.

Without writing four pages to explain the situation of the financial need we will just say that it is to pay the debt to the communication department in Bolivia for use of the radio the last years it was on the air. We have approximately \$1,000 to pay before we can advance with relicensing the station. If the Lord should lead you to help, we would really appreciate it.
