

Talking about The Ten Commandments

22 What should be your attitude toward the law?

Since the law shows me God's will, I should love it and follow it, even though I know Jesus has fully kept the law to give me salvation, and there is nothing more that I need to do to be saved.

23 What is the central teaching of the law?

The central teaching of the law is to love God and my neighbor.

Matthew 22:37-40 "And he said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the great and first commandment. And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets."

Luke 10:27 "And he answered, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself."



24 What two things do you need to remember as you study each commandment?

In each commandment I must remember the evil which God forbids and the good which He requires.

25 What did God say before He gave the Ten Commandments to Moses?

He said, "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery" (Exodus 20:2).

26 Why was this introduction given?

It was given to show that God loved His people and that He acted to help them in a particular time and place and that His action towards them was one of kindness.
