 - Cause godly living, and therefore your blessings and the flourishing of lives and society, to abound.

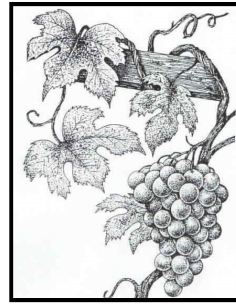
