
Make Christmas more joyful for families touched by prison as we partner once again with Prison Fellowship and provide gifts for 30 local children who have a parent incarcerated.

What if they could be trained to use their quiet empathy to disarm hostility and create unexpected openness to Christ?

#### Session 1: Aligning with God

- What if evangelism was actually a process like farming, and the quiet seed-planters and irrigators were just as important as the harvesters to God's work getting done?
- And so, we begin with aligning with God first and foremost. To do that we practice the confess-yield-ask habit of aligning with the Holy Spirit.

#### **Session 2: Leveraged Listening**

- What if our quieter brothers and sisters bring a great deal to the table?
- What if they had the most badly needed skills for right now: Noticing, thoughtfulness, helping, natural empathy, gaining trust skills, picking up on distress signals and showing empathy, picking up on unmet needs and meeting them?

We'll therefore teach them how to cultivate empathy, to listen for the issue behind the issue, to recognize that people do
to others what was already done to them, to see hurt behind people acting up and acting out with gospel eyes and have
compassion, and to gently interview others about their everyday life and earn the right to ask about deeper things going
on inside.

#### **Session 3: Quietly Effective Gospel Praying**

- What if our quieter people who love their private prayer closet could learn how to locate more people in their world than they realize are there, and begin to pray gospel prayers for these folks?
- We'll look systematically around "our world" of everyday acquaintances and social circles, then create a prayer list we can use. We'll learn biblical prayers to pray for the lost, and four prayers to pray for ourselves in the gospel work.

#### Session 4: A Quiet Kind of Healing Peace-Making

- What if we could train our quieter folks to help angry people turn their arguments into explanations, and turn hostility into the stories of harm behind it?
- What if they could learn to use a kind of defenseless humility and asking for pardon to drain the anger away and create new openness to Christ?
- We'll practice drawing out others gently, and practice how to pour grace into unresolved hurts so the love of God can flow.

#### Session 5: Joining Together to Love Our Neighbors

• What if we could get our quieter people to brainstorm together, using their well of deep caring and storehouse of observations, to come up with even better ways of doing what we already do or new ways of showing love to our community?
