Message from the Chair

We were saddened to hear of the death of Edouard Le Maistre in hospital on Saturday 29 October following a long illness. Edouard was a major figure in Churches Together for many years. Young people grew up thinking of him as "The Big Man" because he had the stature of a giant. One abiding memory is of Edouard holding the large wooden cross at the front of the March of Witness that Churches Together used to do on Good Friday. His death was like the toppling of a mighty oak. The funeral arrangements have not yet been made.

Our thoughts and prayers are with Edouard's widow Jenny at this time. We observed a minute's silence in memory of Edouard at the Churches Together Council meeting on 26 October. Those present signed a card of condolences for Jenny.

At the Council meeting we also learned more about the Godalming Minster project from Canon John Harkin and Rev Simon Taylor. The Minster will go live on 1 January 2024, subject to formal approval by the Church of England. Work is in hand to manage the transition.

Churches Together will be represented at the annual Remembrance Sunday service on Sunday 13 November.

The monthly Prayer Breakfast will take place at 8.30am on Saturday 26 November. Venue to be announced.

Godalming Minster

The parishes of St Peter and St Paul's Church with St Mark's Church, Busbridge and Hambledon have voted in favour of uniting to become one parish known as Godalming Minster. Voting took place at three separate meetings for members on the electoral rolls at Godalming on 2 October, and at Hambledon and Busbridge on 16 October. The vote for the Minster will enable the growth of Christian mission across the Godalming area, maintain and develop diverse styles of worship, provide better support for the clergy and provide a coherent strategy across the four churches of St Peter and St Paul's with St Mark's, Busbridge and Hambledon.
