Because you guys are getting every answer right on every sermon note, I am kicking up the difficulty a notch. All the answers are in the sermon, but they don't appear as points on a slide and I won't be giving you verbal clues like "hey, this is in your sermon notes". Listen carefully!

1. In Jeremiah 5:30-31, you might think the "appalling and horrible thing" was (use your own phrasing): \_\_\_\_\_  
\_\_\_\_\_ but actually, it was that 3 groups were falling away from God. The 3 groups were p\_\_\_\_\_, p\_\_\_\_\_ and p\_\_\_\_\_. (V 31)
2. In Isaiah 30:8-12 we see a sad tale progress before us
  1. The children were rebellious and lying, but the core problem was that they were un\_\_\_\_\_ to h\_\_\_\_\_ (V9)
  2. They wanted their leaders to substitute the Word of God with sm\_\_\_\_\_ th\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_. (V10)
  3. And they certainly did NOT want to hear more about the \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_.
  4. God sees this progression as d\_\_\_\_\_ his W\_\_\_\_\_ (1st half in v12).
