#### **MINISTRY UPDATE**

Thank you for all of the encouraging feedback many of you gave after posting our first ministry update video last month! The Lord continues to bless and increase our support every week, helping us reach our goal of being in South Africa, Lord willing, by July 2023.

We have had a very busy month of travel beginning in Ohio then down to South Carolina, Georgia, back to South Carolina and soon-to-be North Carolina & New Hampshire. When all is said and done from this 39-day trip, we will have traveled over 4,000 miles.

With all of the busyness, we decided to pull our house from the market. God didn't sell it quickly, much to the surprise of many realtors who knew we were selling in our hot Indiana market, so we know it just wasn't God's timing. Our hearts weren't really in the selling of it, knowing it would rush us out of the house without being able to have the time to purge and carefully pack for South Africa.

It was amazing to see, but days after we took it off the market, God placed multiple, knowledgeable people in our path who have advised we try to rent our home rather than sell it. It would not only give us a place to "park" near our sending church when home on furloughs but also provide some additional income to speed us on our way to South Africa. We are now pursuing this possibility with our HOA board (as it would require special permission), and we are working with a former missionary, now realtor, to help us find the right rental management group. This has all just been a wonderful reminder that when we are seeking God's will, He will direct us 100%. We don't know how this home process will end, but we know God will continue to lead in His perfect way!

Traveling around the country often brings us close to family or friends. Paige Williams has become like family since traveling with us during our survey trip to South Africa in July 2021. We were able to have lunch with her while in Greenville, SC recently and heard about her exciting new missions trip this coming summer to help share the gospel and work in researching global health issues in Ghana. Our travels prevent us from getting a dog until we reach South Africa, but we are just so incredibly relieved and encouraged that their fears are disappearing. God is so good!
