What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? When St. Paul's Cathedral opened in London in 1708, it was hailed as a marvel of architectural design and beauty. Because of the curved design, people standing in the gallery above the nave found that they could hear a whisper from the other side of the church, and it came to be known as the Whispering Gallery. The story goes that one day a young couple were talking in the gallery. The man, who was a shoemaker told the lady that because his business was struggling, he could not buy leather to make more shoes, and thus could not afford to marry her. A man on the other side of the gallery heard their sorrow and followed the young man to his shop. He then anonymously paid for and had delivered a large shipment of leather, saving the business and allowing the couple to wed. It was not until many years
