Welcome Home Church Family! Sunday • December 04, 2022

We made it to December! It's amazing how fast this year has flown by. Last week we began our Christmas series, "Don't Let the World Steal Your Christmas" with the focus on spending time at the feet of the Savior rather than get caught up in the hustle and bustle of the season. We talked about the need to clear our calendars of some things that were diverting our attention away from the true meaning of the season. I used the story of

"How the Grinch Stole Christmas" as a way to draw the comparison of how the evil one wants to kill, steal, and destroy during the Christmas season. The world can take away everything and try to steal our joy through busyness, anxiety, depression, and more. However if our hearts and minds are focused on what really matters, then no matter what is thrown at us, Jesus will always be the ONE that rules in and through our lives!

This coming Sunday, we have another opportunity to join together as a church family as we celebrate our Savior through "The Roots of Christmas - Tree Decorating Service". We love to combine traditional values with music, carols, the Christmas Story, specials, and of course the tree decorating. This is a wonderful service to invite the community to! We will

be only doing this one time @ 10:30 am followed by our Christmas potluck luncheon. I want to encourage you to bring a dish to share so there will be plenty of food to go around. There will be no Sunday School that morning.

Finally we have 2 other events coming up down the stretch towards Christmas day. On December 16 @ 6 pm, we will have having a "Christmas" Family Movie Night in the Field featuring "How the Grinch Stole Christmas", complete with hot cocoa and a few friends who will be stopping by to pay a visit. Bring your cameras, a lawn chair, and dinner. Make yourselves comfortable and enjoy the night!

Our other event brings us to our Christmas Eve service on December 23 and 24 at 5 pm. These will be identical services. We will have nursery available for birth-3 years of age, but we are still needing a few people to serve one night or the other. If you can help, please contact Dee Helbig and let her know. Each service will contain Christmas music, carols, drama, a brief message, and a candlelight time of worship. Plan on inviting your friends and family and make an evening out of it. On Christmas morning we will be streaming a special called, "An EG First Family Christmas Morning". It will be a lookback over the past year, along with special packaged Christmas musical specials, the Christmas Story with the pastors and their families, thoughts from each pastor on the Joy of Christmas and more. 
