Church Committees

- Bereavement Committee – organizes ministry to the church family or their immediate relatives in time of bereavement.
- Recreation Committee – works with Recreation Pastor in planning the recreation ministries and enlisting volunteers for programs and Recreational Outreach Center workers.
- Youth Committee – supports the youth pastor in planning and implementing a correlated calendar of activities that will involve students in a consistent, well-rounded program of spiritual development.
- Family Life Committee – coordinates a program of activities that encourage "First Family togetherness."
- Audio/Video/Communications Committee – oversees our media and audio-visual ministries and helps enlist people to serve.
- Music/Worship Committee – assists the Worship Pastor in planning, promoting, and evaluating the musical activities of the church and make recommendations for the purchase of necessary musical equipment and supplies.
- Flower/Decoration Committee – provides decorations for worship services and special events in the worship center.
- Children's Committee – recommends and publicizes policies and procedures pertaining to the children's ministry as well as assist with enlistment, training, and screening of workers.
- Preschool Committee – coordinates ministry to preschoolers and parents as well as recommends and publicizes preschool policies and procedures.
- Personnel Committee – provides recommendations for future church staff, oversees evaluations, and promotes the care for and financial well-being of all church staff.
- Stewardship Committee – is responsible for development of a program which includes budget development, budget subscription, budget administration and Biblical stewardship education.
- Nomination Committee – brings nominations to the church for the general officers of the church and assists church leaders in discovering and enlisting persons to lead church programs.

- Grounds Committee – is responsible for supervising the maintenance and improvement of church grounds and for the upkeep of grounds maintenance equipment.
- Building and Space Committee – plans and oversees maintenance of church property and equipment.
- Missions Committee – provides investigation and information for missions locally and globally, as well as determining special offerings.
- Outreach Committee – helps to plan local evangelism events in the community and evangelism training for members.
- Risk Management Committee – has responsibility of studying the insurances coverages available to the church and developing risk assessments for the church.
- Welcome/Usher Committee – is tasked with being the “first face” of the church by greeting, seating, and assisting members and guests.
- Committee on Committees – has the responsibility of surveying, recommending, and presenting to the church for election those members who will serve on all church committees.
- Memorial Committee – works closely with the church staff in determining items to be purchased from monetary gifts given in memory of members.
- Security Committee – develops and implements safety and security protocols for the church.

<h3>Community Organizations</h3>

- Upward Basketball – Christian and Gospel focused basketball league for K-6th grade, runs January to mid-March.
- Hope Cottages – a ministry to homeless moms and their children that has a program helping them get back on their feet and living on their own.
- House of Hope – offers food and shelter to the poor, needy, and homeless, also provide overnight shelter for homeless during the colder winter days.
- Ozark Share and Care – gives assistance to the needy of our community with paying bills, providing food, and clothing.
- Sharing Kitchen – provides a free meal to individuals on Saturdays, operates under Share and Care.
- Arkansas Baptist Ranch – part of the Arkansas Baptist Children’s Homes network, they foster children from same families looking for potential adoptive families for them.
- The Sanctuary – a safe place for women and kids to go who are victims of domestic violence.
- Informed Choices Pregnancy Center – a place where pregnant moms can be educated, supported, and cared for before, during, and after pregnancy. They want to protect the unborn life and help in cases of crisis pregnancies.
- The Call Boone County – organization helping children find foster care homes, as well as educate and support the foster care families that are in the area.
