The Minster Steering Group is busy identifying key tasks and transition challenges which need to be addressed for us to continue to move forward. With the contemporary congregation from Busbridge moving to St Peter and St Paul's Church in 2023, there will need to be re-ordering of the interior of the building to enable it to be better equipped for mission activities. Meetings are currently being held to engage with the short and long-term possibilities this offers.
