BIBLE READINGS FOR NEXT SUNDAY: Isaiah 7:10-17 Romans 1:1-7 Matthew 1:18-25

HYMN OF THE DAY: Our hymn of the day is *Go Tell It on the Mountain*. The night Jesus was born, shepherds kept watch in their fields by night, and angels appeared in the heavens to announce the birth of the savior. He wasn't in a palace in nearby Jerusalem, but lying in a manger in Bethlehem. We all know that part of the story. But do you know what the shepherds did after they found the Christ child? They told others what the angels had told them. Now that we have found the Christ child, we too have the opportunity to share what we have found with others. Go tell it on the mountain!

A WORD: Our Old Testament reading is a picture of life on the way to heaven. Isaiah asks us to imagine a desert made lush from the gift of water. The desert is usually a place of trial and testing, but when God gives his blessing, it becomes a place of abundant life. So we too, as we pass through the desert places of our lives, receive God's blessing and they become places of abundant life. Our epistle reading counsels us to be patient as we wait for the coming of the Lord. Are you in a desert place now? Wait with patience for the gift of rain. When God comes, he will bless. The Gospel reading asks us to give up our ideas of who Christ should be and what he should be doing and accept him for who he is and what he does. Sometimes, we are

like John the Baptist, who asked, "Could this man really be the savior?" Jesus responds to him and to us, "Blessed is the one who does not stumble on account of me."

ABOUT THE BULLETIN COVER: Isaiah presents a beautiful picture of the day when the Lord will make this world right. It is a sight to behold! In His ministry, Jesus literally opened blind eyes to see. At the same time, He was also opening the eyes of faith to see Him as the Messiah. Jesus is still restoring eyes to see right through His Word. Even though today we see dimly, a day is coming when we shall see face to face (1Corinthians 13:12).
