BIBLE READINGS FOR NEXT SUNDAY: Isaiah 63:7-14; Galatians 4:4-7; Matthew 2:13-23

HYMN OF THE DAY: Our hymn of the day is *Joy to the World*. This hymn boldly declares that joy has come to the world because Christ has arrived. This hymn repeats the thought of Psalm 16, "In Your presence, there is fullness of joy." In a world that is gray and cold, everyone seeks joy. But there is only one place where joy can be found. And that place, that person, has come to us on Christmas day, Jesus Christ our Lord.

A WORD: Our readings today help us to understand what God was up to as he sent his son into the world. The Old Testament reading declares that salvation has come because the Lord has arrived. Therefore, we should open the gates of the city and prepare the roads for the coming of the king. In Christ, God is seeking us out, so welcome him when he comes to you with salvation. The epistle reading contrasts God's goodness with our sin. Prior to the coming of Christ, we were foolish, disobedient, led astray, and enslaved to evil passions. What changed this situation? The mercy and loving kindness of God shown to us when the savior came. Finally, Mary gives us an example in the Gospel reading of how we should respond to the Gospel. When she heard the words of the shepherds, she treasured them in her heart. So we, when we hear the words of the Gospel, treasure them in our hearts, and there they go to work in us for salvation.

ABOUT THE BULLETIN COVER: In the mystery of the incarnation, God's power and might have come to us in the form of a vulnerable infant! His holy arm has worked unexpectedly and magnificently by taking on our human flesh in order to save us. For when Christ grew to adulthood, He bared His holy arm in the power of the cross—outstretched for all to see His merciful and unending love.
