MINISTRY UPDATE

Even though we are excited about getting to South Africa, we have often said, "We don't want to waste this time of pre-field ministry." As we look back on this past year, we can see so many lessons that the Lord has taught us through it all! We'd like to share some of these with you:

1. **God's Preservation:** The most exciting part of this past year was hearing the testimonies of long-time friends and new friends as they shared of how God pursued them in spite of themselves to bring them to salvation. We never grow tired of hearing of a changed life because of what Christ has done for us! He has certainly preserved us this year as well in many ways, but we especially praise the Lord for bringing our youngest son to Christ in 2022. Salvation is truly a gift from God (Ephesians 2:8-9)!

2. **God's Protection:** The Lord has kept us safe through thousands and thousands of miles of driving and flying as we visited 53 different churches (some more than once) and countless individuals within 15 states to present our passion and God's calling to Knysna. He has on many occasions this year provided exactly what we needed for repairs, expenses, clothes, food and more--above what we could ask or think. Our faith has been strengthened time and time again through His provision in the great and small. We truly have seen our God "supply all [our] need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus" (Philippians 4:19).
