“The Characters of Christ's Birth”

In 1963, Andy Williams released a new song titled “It's the Most Wonderful Time of the Year” just in time for Christmas. The song is a celebration of the activities associated with the Christmas season, focusing primarily on get-togethers with friends and family, sledding with children, roasting marshmallows, sharing stories about previous Christmases, and singing Christmas carols in winter weather. It is very nostalgic and we still hear that song played many times each Christmas season.

While there is much that we know about Christmas, there is also a lot that we don't know. We have created so many traditions and stories that we often miss what really happened at the birth of Christ.

This coming Advent Season, I would like to preach a series of sermons that I am calling “The Characters of Christ's Birth.” There are many people who feature in the events leading up to and in the birth of Christ. However, this year I would like to focus on just a few. (Perhaps next year we may look at a few others.) I would like to examine the birth of Christ from the perspective of Joseph (actually, Pastor Simmons will preach about Joseph), Zechariah and Elizabeth, the wise men, and Mary. Each of these persons were used by God to play a significant role in the birth of Christ. At first, they struggled to understand all that God was doing. But over time, they came to understand God's incredible plan and they participated in a most wonderful manner.

The God-Man, Jesus Christ, was born in Bethlehem to Mary. He lived in obscure Nazareth. His short ministry of three years in Israel rocked the nation. He was eventually crucified on a Roman cross in Jerusalem. But, astonishingly, three days later he was raised back to life. And the world has never been the same!

I hope you will join Pastor Scott Simmons and me as we examine "The Characters of Christ's Birth" this Advent Season.



This month, the ESL Program will wrap up the First Semester of 2022-2023. This semester 54 students from 21 countries participated in 8 classes each week.

We are so grateful for our new ESL Administrative Team, which includes Barb Hess, Andrea Proctor, and Melissa Noel. The ESL Administrative Team mails class materials, devotions, and announcements to students. Their efforts not only support effective instruction but also provide students with printed Bible verses

The ESL teachers and ESL Administrative Team met in November to plan events, review student feedback, and discuss current needs. The verse that comes to mind is Matthew 9:37 (ESV): Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few." God has blessed the ESL Program and new students continue to join every week. For the Second Semester, there is a need for an additional Beginner Class and interest in Conversation Classes at both the Beginner Level and the Intermediate/Advanced Level. By offering English classes, we have the opportunity to build relationships with people from many countries and backgrounds, share Bible verses and devotions with them, and pray for them.
