“God’s Special Invitation”

Revelation 3:20

“Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me” (Revelation 3:20 NIV).

1. Jesus _____!

“... If **anyone hears my voice and opens the door**, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with me” (Revelation 3:20 NIV).

“No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws them, and I will raise them up at the last day” (John 6:44 NIV).

The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, **not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance** (2 Peter 3:9 NIV).

“For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that **whoever believes in him** shall not perish but have eternal life” (John 3:16 NIV).

2. Jesus _____.

“I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot. I wish you were either one or the other! So, because you are luke-warm—neither hot nor cold—I am about to spit you out of my mouth” (verses 15-16).

3. _____.

You say, ‘I am rich; I have acquired wealth and do not need a thing.’ But you do not realize that you are wretched, pitiful, poor, blind and naked. I counsel you to buy from me gold refined in the fire, so you can become rich; and white clothes to wear, so you can cover your shameful nakedness; and salve to put on your eyes, so you can see (verses 17-18a).
