

**Community Church of PK Monthly Members Meeting
January 15, 2023**

The January Business Meeting was called to order by Council Assistant Moderator Terry Reynolds at 1:02 pm on Sunday, January 15, 2023. Opening prayer was given by Pastor Terry Reynolds. There were 18 members present.

December Business Meeting Minutes and Financials were approved as posted.

Old Business

The new council has elected officers and they are as follows: Moderator- Tammy Marsh, Assistant Moderator- Terry Reynolds, Secretary- Rebecca Lightner.

The Healthy Home Conference is tentative set for March 25, 2023. The requested budget that is up for vote is \$5,000. Kay made a motion to use \$5,000 from the mission contingency fund for this conference, seconded by Gene and all approved.

As stated in the last meeting minutes under the Pastor's report, he is requesting funds to be able to do minor repairs/updates to the church. For example, lights on the front of church need replaced, redo the parking lot stripes, update the signs at the playground, reseal the gym floor, and work on the 3 crosses area in front of the church as well as working on moving the sign in front closer to the road where it would be more visible. His estimated budget for this is \$5,200. Andy made a motion to use \$5,200 out of the building and grounds fund for this. Seconded by Gio, and all approved.

Andy made a motion for the mission distribution checks to be written for the months of July-December 2022, Kay seconded and all approved.

The changes to the mission distribution moving forward are: replace New Haven with Circle of Life, take of Gideon International from the biannual. We are adding 3 missionaries at \$50 monthly as well. For more information on these missionaries please see Jack. Gene made a motion, Letha seconded, and all approved for the changes moving forward to mission distribution.

Replacing one of the church vans is staying under old business in case an opportunity presents itself for getting something better we can move forward with voting on that.

The payroll changes that were previously approved, turned out to be really expensive so for the time being, Rebecca has set us up with Sure Payroll. The cost is \$40 monthly, and this includes unlimited checks and W2 processing fees; Rebecca does the payroll using their software from the office. If anyone has any questions, please see Rebecca.

The 501C3 application has been sent to the IRS, the fee was \$600 and was taken from the building and grounds fund.

Women's & Men's bible study begins Jan 19th, everyone will meet at the church at 6:15pm, then we will head out to our destination. We will be studying the book the Circle Maker, books provided.
