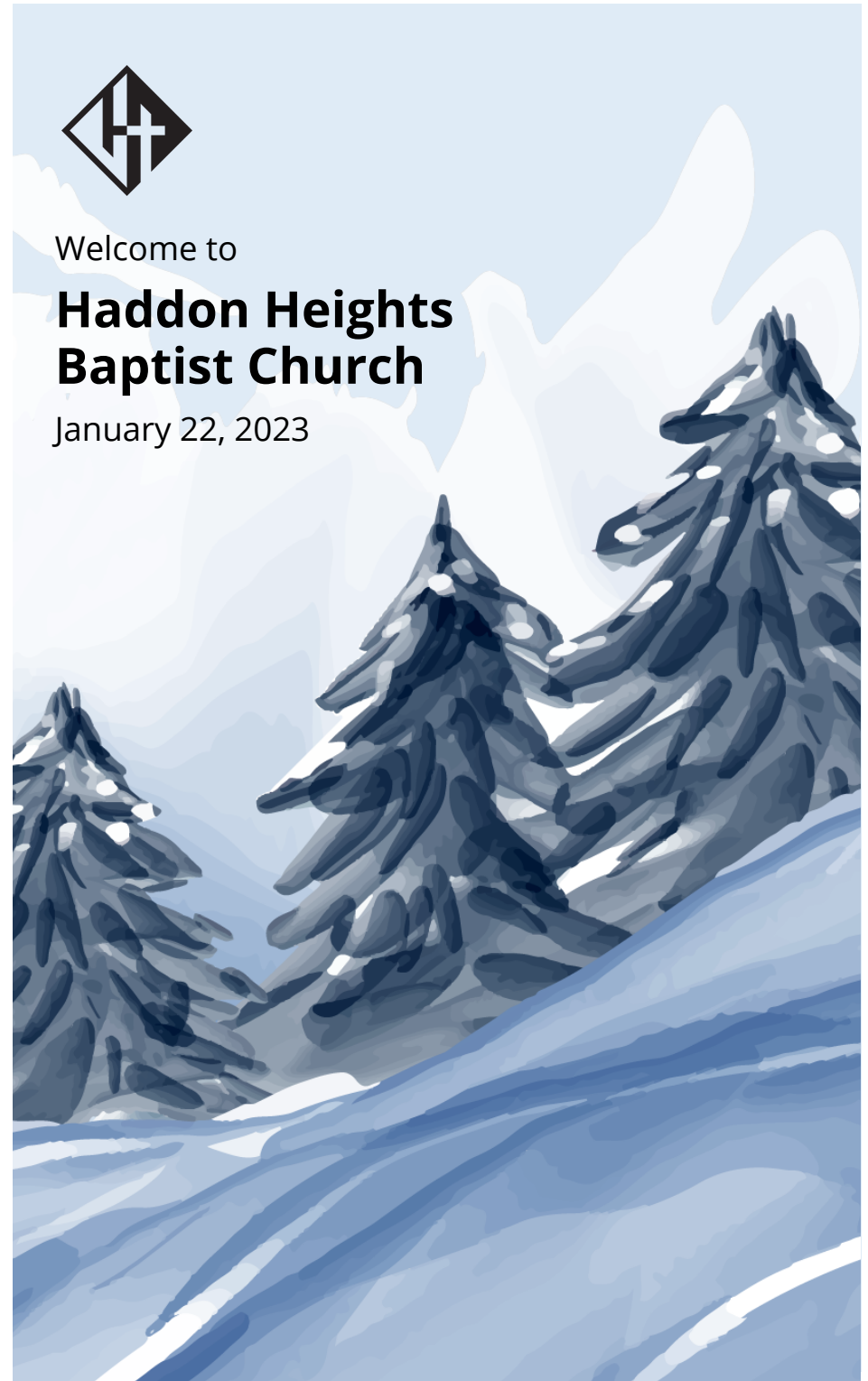

Dear Church Family,

Good morning! I am excited to worship the Lord together with you today and trust you are well. If you are visiting, thank you for being here.
