LESSONS FROM FIRST SAMUEL

1 Samuel 22:13-16 Saul said to him, "Why have you conspired against me, you and the son of Jesse, giving him bread and a sword and inquiring of God for him, so that he has rebelled against me and lies in wait for me, as he does today?" 14 Ahimelek answered the king, "Who of all your servants is as loyal as David, the king's son-in-law, captain of your bodyguard and highly respected in your household? 15 Was that day the first time I inquired of God for him? Of course not! Let not the king accuse your servant or any of his father's family, for your servant knows nothing at all about this whole affair." 16 But the king said, "You will surely die, Ahimelek, you and your whole family."

LESSONS FOR US:

• Beware the slippery slope.

- Apparently, Saul didn't get the message in chapter 19 when the Spirit of God detained Saul and his men when they were trying to capture David. But now in chapter 22 he's accusing a priest, Ahimelek, not only of lying, but of conspiring with David to rebel against him. Saul's sin of trying to kill David, for no good reason, is growing into distrust of priests! And that's not bad enough, but it escalates into ordering the death of the priest and his whole family! In 22:19 we see he also had the entire city of Nob killed with the sword; men (85 of which were priests), women, children, infants, cattle, donkeys and sheep. Saul keeps **slipping** deeper and deeper into sin.
- Galatians 5:7-9 "You were running a good race. Who stopped you from following the true way? 8 This change did not come from the One who chose you. 9 Be careful! "Just a little yeast makes the whole batch of dough rise." New Century Version
