

This past week, we had to make our first trip to the US Embassy in London in order to renew the kid's passports for this upcoming process. We are coming up on 5 years of being here in Wales and will be eligible to apply for our "Indefinite to Remain" Visas, which will allow us to remain in the UK indefinitely along with other benefits. The application process is tedious and extremely expensive. The overall fees are going to cost us approximately \$15,000.00. Again, we please ask you to pray for this significant step in our ministry and would greatly appreciate any financial help in meeting this need.
