2023 VISION: BE WITH JESUS. BECOME LIKE JESUS. DO WHAT JESUS DID. "Lord, Teach Us to Pray" Luke 11:1

"Lord, teach us to pray ..." (Luke 11:1 NIV).

One day Jesus was praying in a certain place. When he finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray, just as John taught his disciples" (Luke 11:1 NIV).

What was it about Jesus' prayer life that so captivated His disciples?

1. Prayer was an essential way that Jesus	S

"Now they know that everything you have given me comes from you. For I gave them the words you gave me and they accepted them. They knew with certainty that I came from you, and they believed that you sent me" (John 17:7-8 NIV).

Jesus gave them this answer: "Very truly I tell you, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does. For the Father loves the Son and shows him all he does. Yes, and he will show him even greater works than these, so that you will be amazed" (John 5:19-20 NIV).

2. Jesus made prayer a ______.

Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed (Mark 1:35 NIV).

One of those days Jesus went out to a mountainside to pray, and spent the night praying to God (Luke 6:12 NIV).

Yet the news about him spread all the more, so that crowds of people came to hear him and to be healed of their sicknesses. But Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed (Luke 5:15-16 NIV).

3. Through prayer Jesus ____

Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed. Simon and his companions went to look for him, and when they found him, they exclaimed: "Everyone is looking for you!"

Jesus replied, "Let us go somewhere else—to the nearby villages—so I can preach there also. That is why I have come." So he traveled throughout Galilee, preaching in their synagogues and driving out demons (Mark 1:35-39 NIV).
