The Calling of God

Through Easter Sunday, we are going to gain a deeper understanding of the call of God in the life of a believer. 2 Thessalonians 2:13–14 (NKJV) says, "But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God from the beginning chose you for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth, to which He called you by our gospel, for the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ."

God's calling starts with Him inviting or summonsing us. The calling leads to proclaiming the name of God. Jesus calls you to receive Him as Lord and Savior. When a person responds to the call of salvation, the new Christian grows in Christlikeness, sanctification. The Christian now sees the calling for the work God has for him or her to do. The believer is to always remember the call of God and examine his or her life. Let's be sure of our calling and see our faith and walk with the Lord grow into a deeper relationship with Him.

#### Something To Ponder:

I have several friends in Germany. One in particular is on my mind a lot this week. She is my age. Her first language is Afrikaans; her second language is German. She is also learning English. (She feels her English is poor, but I have to admit it's much better than my German. We coach each other in our language exercises online every week.)

She is also completely bed-bound, living in a government funded and run nursing facility. She is smart, funny, well educated—and she LOVES Jesus. Since her only way to connect to the outside world is via the internet, she watches our livestream EVERY WEEK, carefully calculating the time difference (7 hours) so she can be with us in real time.

She loves singing praises with us, learning the English words to the hymns she knows in German. But her favorite part of the Service? THE CHILDREN'S SERMON.

Bro. Chad brings a message to the children every week, using simple words and simple examples that they can understand. So, it's been perfect for this 52-year-old woman for whom English is her third language. She is not a child, but she willingly becomes "child-like" during the Children's Sermon so she can truly understand the message and learn more about how Jesus works in our lives.

In Matthew 18:2-4 we read, "Jesus called a little child to him and put the child among them. Then he said, 'I tell you the truth, unless you turn from your sins and become like little children, you will never get into the Kingdom of Heaven. So anyone who becomes as humble as this little child is the greatest in the Kingdom of Heaven."

My friend deals with a lot of health and financial problems every day. Yet, she is willing to become like a little child so that she may better know JESUS. I have to ask myself, "Am I willing to be that open to Him?" Are you?
