Annual Business Meeting Update



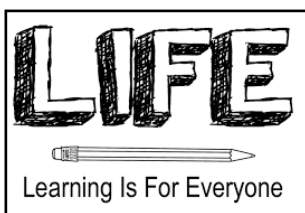

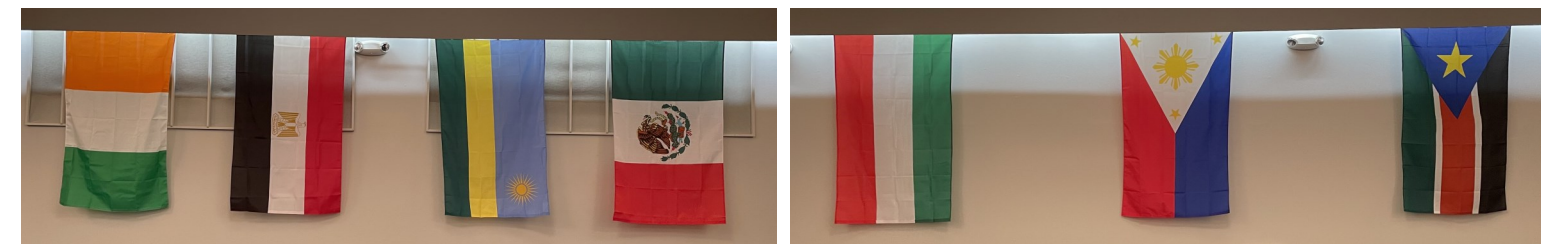
Faith Promise 2023—A Matter of the Heart
