Position: Children's Ministry Director

POSITION SUMMARY

The North Oak Community Church (NOCC) Children's Ministry Director will provide leadership and support to the NOCC Children's Equipping Team and volunteers within children's ministry. The director will focus on spiritual formation of children (birth-5th grade). This focus includes: the nurseries, Children's Church, Sunday School, Vacation Bible School, and our Wednesday after school program (HFL). The Children's Ministry Director should hold to the NOCC mission statement to Grow in Christ, Live Connected, and Take Jesus to Others. (Colossians 2:6-7)

JOB DESCRIPTION AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Children's Ministry Director will:

- Work as a spiritual leader for the Children's equipping Team and volunteer workers.
- Establish and oversee implementation of a strong biblical framework and a love for God's word with birth-5th grade ministries
- Lead bi-monthly meetings, or as needed, for the Team. The director must plan the agenda, conduct the meeting and follow up on discussions as needed
- Recruit, coach, assist, observe and encourage Children's Ministry Volunteers.
- Build a strong team that allows the Children's Ministry Director to serve in a director roll, delegating responsibilities to those on the team.
- Maintain a consistent presence during services, supporting leaders as needed and interacting with parents.
- Meet with Elders as needed
- Meet weekly with the church staff for accountability, reporting, planning and prayer.
- Submit an annual budget and an annual report for the team

OUALIFICATIONS

CALL

- Possess a personal faith and walk with God
- Affirms agreement with the NOCC Statement of Faith
- Has a clear sense that God has prepared him/her for this position
- Is a member or in the process of becoming a member of NOCC

CHARACTER

- Agrees to abide by the NOCC standards of conduct
- Self-starter who is able to work independently, recognize needs/gaps/opportunities, and initiate suggestions to improve church processes
- Possessing key character qualities: dependable, encourager, joyful, gentle, loyal, secure, servant-minded, forgiving, self-disciplined

- Kind and nurturing heart eager to serve children of all ages and a desire to build relationships with their parents

SCHEDULE

Schedule will depend on candidates' availability. Primary responsibilities are coordinating Wednesday after school ministry and Sunday morning responsibilities.

Work hours: Hours will vary depending on ministry responsibilities. The position will be listed as a 20-hour work week.

WAGES

Starting wages will be \$16 per hour, based on 20 hours work week

EVALUATION

Initial evaluation will be conducted after 3 months of employment. A second evaluation will be conducted after 6 months of employment. Thereafter, evaluation will be done annually and will include evaluation by the Lead Pastor and a self-evaluation.

BACKGROUND CHECK

Final candidate will have consented to and successfully completed a criminal background check if applicable for the position.
