SESSION TWO: REJOICE IN THE LORD ALWAYS

Philippians 4:4-9

**Point One-**

Rejoice in the Lord always and be reasonable.

Do you look to Christ for your joy in all circumstances? Is the gentleness of Christ evident to those around you?

Point Two-Rejoice in the Lord always with prayer and thanksgiving.

In those dark moments where do you turn? Do you freeze not knowing where to go? Or do you cry out to Christ who gives us the strength? <sup>8</sup> Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence; if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things. <sup>9</sup> What you have learned and received and heard and seen in me– practice these things, and the God of peace will be with you.

# SESSION TWO: REJOICE IN THE LORD ALWAYS \*\*Philippians 4:1-9\*\*

4 <sup>1</sup> Therefore, my brothers, whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, stand firm thus in the Lord, my beloved. <sup>2</sup> I entreat Euodia and I entreat Syntyche to agree in the Lord. <sup>3</sup> Yes, I ask you

also, true companion, help these women, who have labored side by side with me in the gospel together with Clement and the rest of my fellow workers, whose names are in the book of life.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice. <sup>5</sup> Let your reasonableness be known to everyone. The Lord is at hand; <sup>6</sup> do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. <sup>7</sup> And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

## Group Discussion:

1. As we eagerly await his return, how should that affect the way that we live our lives?

2. How are you at encouraging others? Just as a personal application, think of one person that you could write an encouragement note to this week. (We will have cards available if you would like to do that sometime this weekend)

3. How have you seen the Lord at work in your life in the last year, months, week? If you feel comfortable, share a brief testimony with your group. This is a practical way that we "build one another up", and it can be so encouraging to others to hear how God has worked (is working) in your life.

# SESSION ONE: ENCOURAGING ONE ANOTHER 1 Thessalonians 5:8-22

<sup>8</sup> But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, having put on the breastplate of faith and love, and for a helmet the hope of salvation. <sup>9</sup>For God has not destined us for wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, 10 who died for us so that whether we are awake or asleep we might live with him. <sup>11</sup>Therefore encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing. <sup>12</sup> We ask you, brothers, to respect those who labor among you and are over you in the Lord and admonish you, <sup>13</sup> and to esteem them very highly in love because of their work. Be at peace among yourselves.

<sup>14</sup> And we urge you, brothers, admonish the idle, encourage the fainthearted, help the weak, be patient with them all. <sup>15</sup> See that no one repays anyone evil for evil, but always seek to do good to one another and to everyone. <sup>16</sup> Rejoice always, <sup>17</sup> pray without ceasing, <sup>18</sup> give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. <sup>19</sup> Do not quench the Spirit. <sup>20</sup> Do not despise prophecies, <sup>21</sup> but test everything; hold fast what is good. <sup>22</sup> Abstain from every from of evil.
