# MORE THAN A CHURCH WE ARE A FAMILY

Dear Friends,

April 3<sup>rd</sup> will be a special day for me; it marks 12 years since the first Sunday that we spent with you, and with Waveland Covenant. In my journal I noted that on that day, Waveland had seven people in attendance, while at New Market, "I counted 40 in attendance, including 5 teens, a few kids, and a few people about our age. We were very warmly welcomed and JoElla, the church secretary, gave us a tour of the building." My sermon that day was on Hebrews 4:14-5:10 (Jesus the great high priest). Austin Bartlett gave Jacob an origami dragon. I concluded with, "they seemed genuinely happy to have us there."

A twelve-year anniversary would not necessarily warrant a mention in your newsletter, but in this case I think it does. It means that I now have the honor – and it is an honor – of being the longest-serving pastor in the 150 year history of our church. The late Dale Payne served New Market for 11 years, from 1965-1976. Most of the other 62 pastors in our church history served only one, two, or three years, with a few (especially in the last 50 years) serving four or five. Methodists have always been known for moving pastors around (sometimes with good reason, sometimes without), but times are changing, and I have been glad, very glad, to be with you long term.

Back in April 2011, Brooke and I were 38, while Jacob had just turned 7 and was in the first grade. Through these past dozen years, you have been our friends and our family, watching over us and caring for us in every way. We have shared important life moments, welcomed new friends, and said goodbye to others. I have spoken by the side of too many graves, but I thank God that I have had the honor to do so.

During Rev. Payne's tenure here our church witnessed a change in denomination, transforming from a "Methodist Church" to a "United Methodist Church." Now, more than half a lifetime later, we are moving to yet another such momentous change. I thank you for allowing me to be your pastor in these changing times, and I pray that our brightest days together are still ahead.

#### A Note About Church Membership

The guidelines for the upcoming Church Conference vote include the following "at least 2/3 of the professing members present at the vote".

To understand what this means, let's breakdown the statement:

- At least 2/3: this is a minimum of 66.67% of the votes cast must be in favor of disaffiliation for the vote to pass. Per guidelines, any abstained vote will count as a vote to stay with the UMC
- Professing Members: this is any church member on our membership roster. There are two ways to be added to the membership roster:
  - Transfer membership from another church and take public membership vows
  - Baptism & confirmation and take public membership vows

We have reviewed the membership roster and are sending letters to all church members regarding the Church Conference and following up with phone calls and emails. This is required by the District Superintendent prior to the vote.

Present at the Vote: only members verified to the membership roster and physically
present at the vote will receive a ballot. There is no voting by proxy or absentee voting
allowed.

The rules for the vote were set in the Book of Discipline, Paragraph 2553 and are being strictly adhered to by the Indiana Annual Conference.
