"Turning Hearts, Part VI" "Responding to the Love of God...With Corporate Commitment" Malachi 3:16-18 3/26/23

⁵ "Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the great and awesome day of the LORD comes. ⁶ And he will turn the hearts of fathers to their children and the hearts of children to their fathers, lest I come and strike the land with a decree of utter destruction."

- 1) For the last few weeks we have been considering these verses and their **application** to our own lives and the **days** in which we live.
- 2) Thus far, we have seen:
 - a) That our turning can only be **<u>empowered</u>** by a profound understanding of God's **<u>love</u>** to us.
 - i) In both his **<u>Electing</u>** and <u>**Performative**</u> love.
 - b) That the overall response to this love will be lives of **worship**.
 - i) Living sacrifices that are **<u>free</u>**, **<u>pleasing</u>** to God and <u>**reverent**</u>.
 - c) That central to being turned toward him is a **passionate** concern for true **instruction**.
 - i) Impartially **guarded**, taught, and **applied**.
 - d) That these hearts must be hearts of **persevering covenant** faithfulness.
 - i) Through <u>time</u>, disillusionment and the <u>refining</u> process.
 - e) That these are hearts focused on **proper** priorities.
 - i) Centered on the **house** of God: the **church**.
- 3) Today we see that all these things must be secured through **<u>Corporate</u>** Commitment.
 - a) The central reason for this securing is the concept of spiritual <u>entropy</u>.
 - i) **Entropy**: a process of degradation or running down or a trend toward **disorder**. (Merriam-Webster)
 - ii) While the entire universe is subject to **entropy**, it is especially true regarding **spiritual** health and vitality.
 - (1) The standard direction of spiritual health is **downward**.
 - (2) Only by an **infusion** of the power of God does it **gain**.
 - (a) Regular feeding on his **word**, empowered by his **Spirit**.
 - (3) For <u>communities</u>, this gain often comes in waves of renewal/<u>revival</u> of various intensities.
 (a) The <u>Reformation</u> was such a time.
 - b) At these times, those whose hearts have been <u>awakened</u> seek to band together with others, similarly awakened, in order to <u>hold on</u> to what they have received.
 - i) Seeking to **<u>fend</u>** off the spiritual entropy that led them **<u>away</u>** from God in the first place.
 - ii) **This** is what is happening in our text.
- 4) While we are **not** given a lot of information about this banding together that we see here, and while what we are given is somewhat **unclear**, the little we have, **combined** with what we have in other

parts of scripture reveal some of the basic aspects of this corporate commitment that are very **<u>important</u>** for us to understand and embrace.

a) It is **Covenantal**.

- i) There is a **formal** nature to this shared commitment.
- ii) <u>Names</u> are written down.
 - (1) The Book of **<u>Remembrance</u>**. (only time this term is used in scripture)
 - (a) The text does not make clear **<u>who</u>** wrote it and whether it was **<u>literal</u>** or **<u>metaphorical</u>**.
 - i. The scriptures contain references to **<u>both</u>** types.
 - (b) But, in the most **prominent** biblical example of a renewal moment, the writing down of names and commitments was **literal**. **(Nehemiah 9:36-38)**
 - (c) And it seems clear that the speaking going on in verse 16 is a **formal gathering** to discuss the matters that God has presented them through Malachi.
 - (d) And only this kind of formal commitment would **justify** God's **promise** in verse 17.
 - i. **<u>God</u>** goes on record because <u>they</u> have gone on record. (vs. 18)
 - ii. **Separating** themselves from the rest.
 - (2) This is why we have formal **membership**, for it is a formal **commitment**.
 - (a) Otherwise, a relationship to a church is like **<u>cohabitation</u>**.
- b) It is **Confessional**.
 - i) This book of remembrance would surely have <u>included</u> what this list of people was agreeing to.
 (1) Even as the record in <u>Nehemiah</u> did. (Nehemiah 10:28-31ff)
 - (2) Formally **restating** the truths of God that we are **recommitting** to.
 - ii) We **agree** to **agree** about what the truth of God is, and we commit ourselves to **it** as we commit ourselves to **one another**.

c) It is **<u>Cooperative</u>**.

- i) Each one commits to using his/her own unique **<u>gifts</u>/<u>resources</u>** for the good of the whole.
- ii) Doing that which is necessary to keep the community of faith **growing** and on **course**.
 - (1) One **body**, many **members**.
 - (2) Also noted in Nehemiah. (10:28-29)
- d) It is **Confirmed** in **Heaven**.
 - i) God **ardently** approves of these things.
 - (1) He pays **<u>attention</u>** and responds with holy **<u>affirmation</u>**.
 - (2) And assurance that we will, indeed, be <u>saved</u> from the coming <u>wrath</u>.
- 5) The days in which we live place all of these things **before us**.
 - a) Not only are there **signs** everywhere of spiritual **entropy** (degradation),
 - i) There are many **promoting** teachings that are not in line with the **truth** of God.
 - b) But, the voice of <u>Elijah</u> is also speaking today.
 - i) Driving us to the **truth** and driving us to the **cross**.
 - c) It is in **response** to that voice that the Spirit of God has brought us **together**.
 - d) We are told in II Chronicles 16:9 that, "The eyes of the LORD <u>search</u> the whole earth in order to <u>strengthen</u> those whose <u>hearts</u> are fully committed to him."
 - i) May the LORD continually strengthen our hearts as we seek to go forward in **<u>corporate</u> <u>commitment</u>** to him.
