On Easter morning we hear the words of St Peter addressed to Cornelius and his household. He speaks convincingly and easily of what he and those with him have seen, and in particular of "eating and drinking with Jesus after his resurrection from the dead". The events of the life, death and resurrection of Jesus and their sharing in them have touched them and changed them.

To be Christian is to have been touched and changed by the life, death and resurrection of Jesus. Our regular "eating and drinking with him after his resurrection from the dead" in the Mass sustains and continues that change in us. To come close to the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus, to "hold the death of the Lord deep in our hearts", whether by choice or by circumstance, is almost always a traumatic experience and runs against the way most people think the world ought to work. Yet we know that it is the only path to wholeness and lasting happiness.

Those who have been through this trauma are bound together by what they have seen and experienced – they become a gathering, an *ekklesia,* a church. We need the support of one another to make sense of it and to see and understand more clearly how Jesus continues to be present in our lives. We need the support of one another too, to live out its consequences – whether by way of common action or more often by way of a place to which we can return after a hard day in the vineyard.

This is why we have chosen Eastertide as the time to engage with the 'Our Parish Community' initiative in the Diocese, strengthening the ways in which we welcome and support one another and provide a family for all. Wishing you every blessing. Fr Jonathan
