## Fourth Sunday of Easter 30th April 2023

The scriptures and the prayers of the Mass on this fourth Sunday of Easter offer to us the image of Jesus the Good Shepherd. A whole 'symphony of vocations' within the Church, the body of Christ, serve to make present the Good Shepherd for us. I hope and pray that our new parish groups will become one way of helping us to experience the shepherding which we are called to minister to one another.

This week I would like to ask you to pray for me, and for my brother priests – that our hearts and our lives may become always more like Jesus, the Good Shepherd. As with every Christian, we experience in our lives that mix of the divine and human, of the working of the grace of the Holy Spirit and our resistance and fragility.

I would also like to ask you to pray seriously and intently for vocations to priesthood for our Diocese and from our parish. Fr Martin Jakubas played the organ as a boy for weddings here and now rests among us in Eashing cemetery. Fr John Cooke, who was at Seminary with me, is a priest in Fareham in Portsmouth Diocese. Both were baptised here at St Edmund's. Jesus asks us to pray that the Lord will send labourers into his harvest – such labourers come from parishes like ours and from families like ours.

I do not think I would be a priest if the priests and people of my parish had not prayed for it, and my parents had not been open to it. Sometimes we need to pray with expectation. And here we need to acknowledge that it is not an easy time to consider 'entering the church' or to pray that our young people will spend their lives in her service: like every institution today, she suffers from a mixed history and a lack of confidence. More than ever, then, we need to remember that service in the church has its origins and present meaning in a living relationship with Jesus, the Good Shepherd, and to try to build a *culture of vocation* in which being Christian carries with it a call to serve, and to build up the body of Christ, and not simply to be one who has received from the Father's love.

Pray for our young people – that they will know the fullness of God's love for them, hear his call to serve, and receive the courage and support to respond with generous hearts.
