a message from OUR ELDERS

Greetings from the elders

It is the heart of the elders to solemnly devote ourselves to prayer, (Colossians 4:2), to pray continually, (1 Thessalonians 5:17, Ephesians 6:18), and to pray expectantly, (John 15:7, 2 Chronicles 7:14, Psalm 145:18, and Matthew 21:22).

We also want to encourage everyone to remain in prayer for the leadership of Central Park Christian Church. We covet your prayers. There are so many stories packed throughout Scriptures where God's people fasted and prayed, where they lay prostrate before the Lord God Almighty, and cried out for mercy and help. If it were not for the cries of God's people in Egypt, would He have heard them crying out and sent Moses to set them free? Probably not. It's our responsibility to cry out in times of need.

As we continue to work through this transition of not having a senior pastor to shepherd the flock here at Central Park, we want to use the time that's before us to seek God's favor. That's why we are asking everyone to join us in prayer. Sometimes we may not even know what to pray for and that's okay too. We still need to take time every day to come before the Lord our God in prayer. In Romans 8:26, we are told that the Spirit Himself groans within us when we do not know what to pray. That's a pretty incredible promise. We ask with anticipation that God Himself will hear our cries. That He will bless us and the generations to come with great leadership, bringing glory to His name, and spreading the gospel in truth and good deeds.

Remember that Elijah was a man just like us. He prayed earnestly that it would not rain and it did not rain on the land for three and a half years. Again he prayed, and the heavens gave rain and the earth produced it crops (James 5:17-18). It is our belief that when we cry out earnestly, God will hear His people, and will move mightily, and provide the shepherd, He has chosen to lead this flock. We believe when we ask, He will hear. When He hears, He will answer.

Hebrews 10:19-25 says, "Therefore brothers, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place, by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is, His body, and since we have a great high priest over the hose of God, let us draw near to God with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for He Who promised is faithful. And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another – and all the more, as you see the day approaching."

This week we are opening up the church to come together in corporate prayer. (See page 3 for more details.) We will continue to pray together as elders and leaders of Central Park Christian Church as we encourage you to join us when you can. Jesus said, "My Father's house will be a house of prayer." (Matthew 21:13) Let's join in prayer.

- "I don't know how to handle this situation."


It covers a lot of I don't knows.

Psalms 19:1-2 "The heavens declare the glory of God; And the firmament shows His handy work. Day unto day utters speech. And night unto night reveals knowledge."

Psalm 19:1-2 may possibly be some of my favorite verses in all of scripture. I love the picture it paints in my mind. The sun, moon, oceans, stars, mountains, deserts, rivers, trees, flowers, and even weeds glorify God. All creation cries out and declares how great God is. I think it's safe to believe the glory of God is revealed through His creation.

Enter my recent word from the Lord. God has been constantly whispering in my ear the phrase "The glory of God is revealed through the hearts of His followers". The first time I heard that I thought it was a silly idea. How can that be my responsibility? My heart cannot reveal God's glory? My heart loves God, I love God, but I cannot be responsible for that can I? In that moment the Holy Spirit brought this verse to mind.

Proverbs 4:20-23 "My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings. Do not let them depart from your eyes; Keep them in the midst of your heart; For they are life to those who find them, And health to all their flesh. Keep your heart with all diligence, For out if it springs forth the issues of life."

If as a follower of Jesus I am guarding my heart, and paying close attention to the words and teachings of my Father should not my words, and actions reveal His glory? If the fathers glory is in my heart as it is when I look at creation, read His word, and worship him, then the natural - or rather supernatural - symptom would be the overflowing of that glory into everything else I do. So here's my question for you. Are your heart and your life declaring the glory of God. If not, why? And I would ask as I have done myself, for you to seek the answer to that question. And I pray that together as a church we can all declare the glory of God. and through our lives His love and glory would be revealed to those around us.

Not Enough Room for Two

I sat down to have a little prayer time the other day and as soon as I closed my eyes, God put this simple short prayer on my lips,

"Lord, fill me with you so there's no more room left for me."

I didn't mean to pray that, I hadn't been thinking that thought, I just went into my prayer time, opened my mouth and that came out. Then I stopped, I was done, that's all God needed to hear me say at that particular moment.

Since that day, I have included that one sentence almost every time I've prayed. I say it in my morning prayer, in my short prayers throughout the day, in my prayers as I fall asleep, I even said it during corporate prayer at the elders meeting this week. It has become my mantra, my motto, and my goal.

Although I wasn't thinking of this song when God gave me that one-line prayer, it reminded me afterwards of a great worship song from several years ago. "Empty Me" by Chris Sligh. It's hard to even call it a one-hit-wonder song since it was really only around for about six months about a year after the artist was on American Idol. It's a song that was written after Chris's stint on the show and dealing with the spotlight it brought him and a confession of him letting that replace God. The hook in the chorus is "Lord, empty me so I can be filled with You."

It's a great song that says pretty much the same thing that I prayed but with one little difference, the song asks the Lord to "empty me" to make room for Him. Apparently the Father thought that my situation was a little more urgent than that because my the prayer He gave me completely eliminated the "emptying" step and invited God to fill me up so much that it forced out anything that was there in the first place...including myself.

This prayer has led me on a search through the word that landed me on Paul's prayer for spiritual strength for the Ephesians.

^{*14}For this reason I bow my knees before the Father, ¹⁵from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named, ¹⁶that according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being, ¹⁷so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith—that you, being rooted and grounded in love, ¹⁸may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, ¹⁹and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God."

I think this little prayer will be on my heart for a while...




