Do You See What I See?

At the time I am writing this, our youth are off at Christ In Youth (CIY). While they are there, those of us back home have seen some amazing work going into getting CPCC ready for Vacation Bible School (VBS). Which, by the way, has a very special place in my heart. Part of my personal testimony centers around the woman that always lead our craft times at VBS when I was growing up. I don't remember the stories we learned about, or all the fun stuff we got to do every summer during VBS, but I could never forget the joy of that woman. She would be forever surrounded with chaos. There was spilled glue, glitter everywhere, cut up pieces of paper and cloth, cloths pins, paper bags, cups of dirt with seeds planted in them, half started (or finished depending on how you looked at it) crafts that were piled up all around, plates, cups, bowls, wrappers and kids. Kids were busy digging through all that stuff. Some were not very happy and some were even somehow upset, but no matter the day or how crazy things got, that woman just kept on smiling and sincerely loving every moment of serving the Lord with everything that she had. For years, I watched her joy and I could not help but think about how I knew I wanted what she had, but what made her so joyful?

As we see all the preparations going into getting us ready for VBS, I cannot think about our body of workers here at CPCC without feeling overwhelmed by God's amazing love and seeing that same joy at work in the hearts and faces of everyone that's pouring into getting us ready for VBS. God, in His great mercy, has gifted each one of us with amazing abilities to serve in our own special ways. When we allow Him to direct our paths, we shine in His brilliance. One of the super cool things is God has brought us all together and gives each of us opportunities or, good works prepared in advance. "For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do to bring glory to Him." - Ephesians 2:20. And the worst part is we never know when our time will run out.

What can I do? How can I make the best of the time I have been given? I know I am supposed to cast my cares on Christ and I have. But the Lord has been challenging him recently to just take time on to stop and pray with his team and, on top of that, to have a bible devotional during the band's worship practice time to start the day. The outcome, he explained, is almost like when he takes time to stop in the busyness of everything - it's like God is adding extra time to his morning.

I can say the very same thing. In a summer with middle school camp, CIY, VBS, and a baby on the way I feel like I never have enough time.


