Hermann L. Strack and Paul Billerbeck's *A Commentary on the New Testament from the Talmud & Midrash* is an important reference work for illustrating the concepts, theological background, and cultural assumptions of the New Testament. Hermann Strack (1848–1922) was a German Orientalist and theologian. He studied rabbinics under Jewish-Bohemian scholar Moritz Steinschneider.

Paul Billerbeck (1853–1932) was a German Lutheran minister and scholar of Judaism.

LESSON 5

O-Stem Nouns (Second Declension)

e identify verbs by the stems and endings they use. Similarly, we identify nouns and adjectives by their case endings. Like verbs, nouns and adjectives consist of three parts: root, stem, and ending. The case system in Greek includes three types of stems: O-stems, A-stems, and consonant stems. These three types of stems combine with case endings to create three patterns, called "declensions."

Nearly all nouns in the O-stem pattern—or "second declension" are masculine (see Lesson 7 for further discussion of gender and nouns). These nouns all have an o/ε variable vowel for a stem before the case ending. O-stem nouns are declined as follows:
